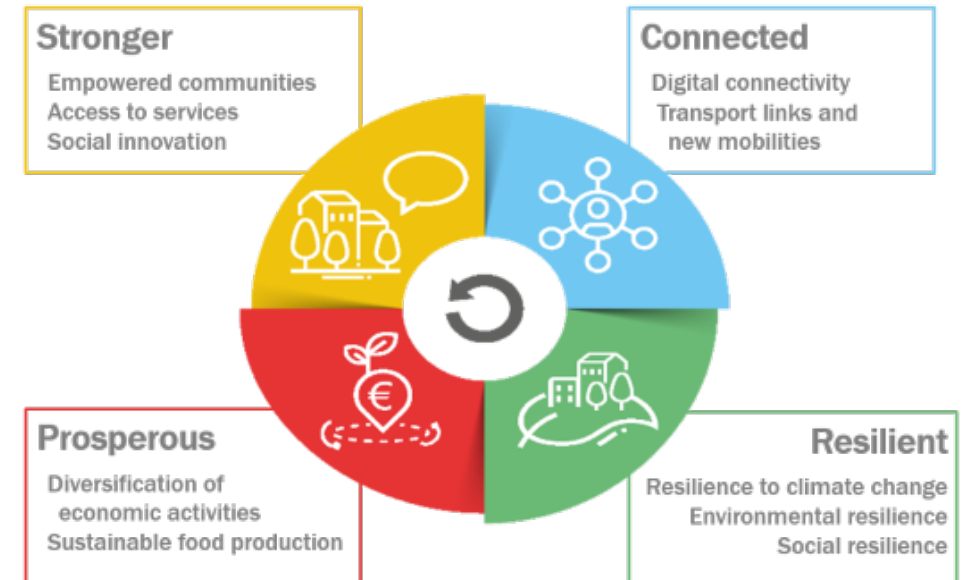
EL maapiirkondade pikaajaline visioon



4 valdkonda

Maapiirkondade arengu pikaajalises visioonis ja tegevuskavas on määratud kindlaks neli tegevusvaldkonda, mida toetavad juhtalgatused, et maapiirkonnad oleksid:

- **tugevamad**, asetades rõhu maakogukondade mõjuvõimu suurendamisele, teenuste kättesaadavamaks tegemisele ja sotsiaalsele innovatsioonile;
- **ühendatud**, parandades nii transpordi- kui ka digiühendusi;
- **vastupanuvõimelised**, säilitades loodusvarasid ja muutes põllumajanduse keskkonnahoidlikumaks, et võidelda kliimamuutuste vastu, tagades samal ajal sotsiaalse vastupanuvõime, pakkudes koolituskursusi ja mitmekesise kvaliteetse töö võimalusi;
- **jõukad**, mitmekesistades majandustegevust ning suurendades põllumajanduse, põllumajandusliku toidutööstuse ja agroturismi lisandväärtust.

Maapiirkonda puudutavate poliitikate ja fondide sünergia ja koordineerimine (nt. ÜPP, struktuurifondid)

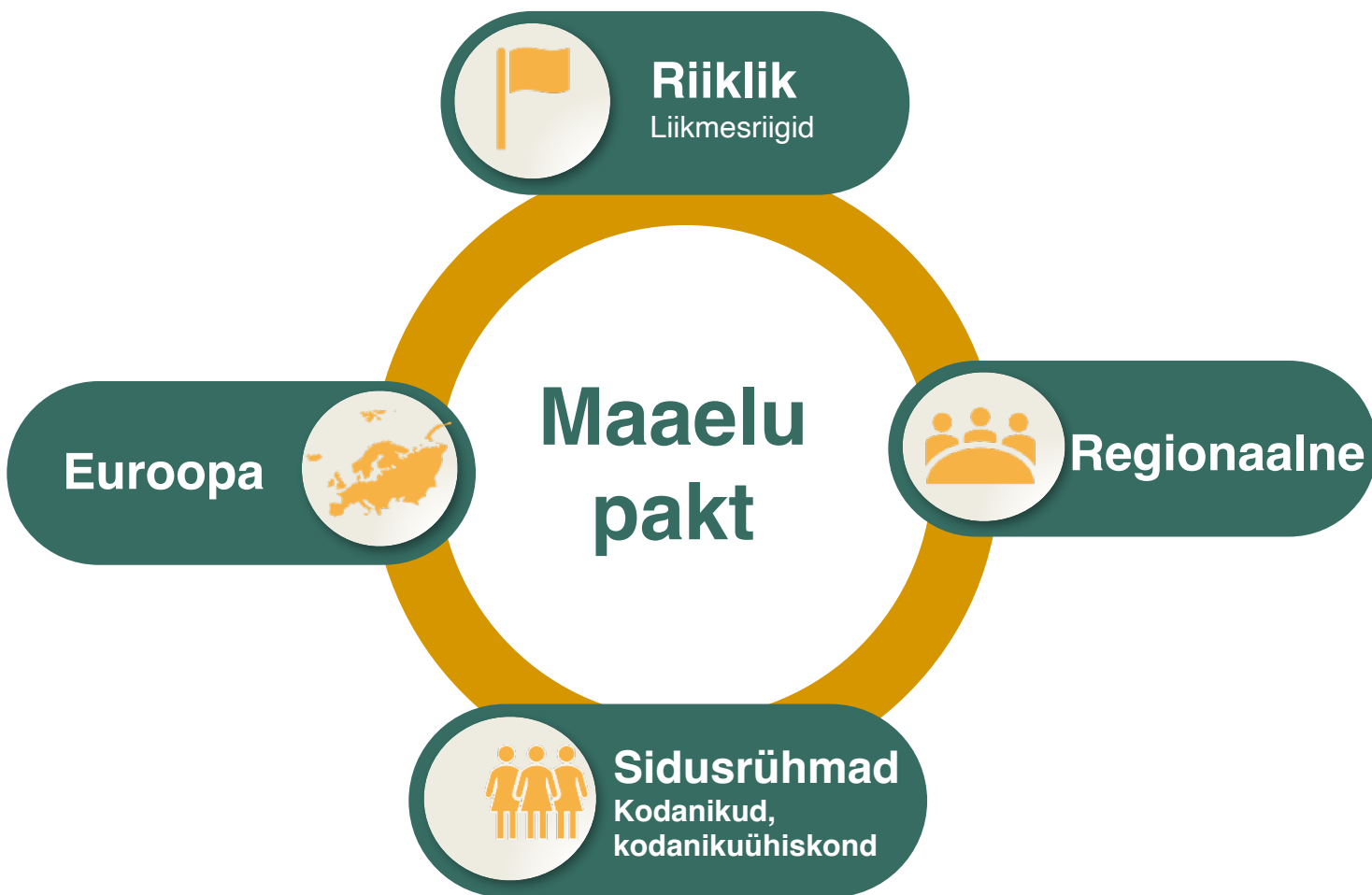

Multifondid 2014 kuni 2020

- ▶ 3333 tegevusrühma (nii maa- kui linnapiirkonnas)
- ▶ 2830 tegevusrühma kasutasid EAFRD LEADER-meedet
- ▶ 624 tegevusrühma kasutasid multifonde (vähemalt 2 fondi)
- ▶ 314 kasutasid EAFRD + ERDF + ESF
- ▶ 9 tegevusrühma kasutasid kõiki 4 fondi



Multifondid 2023 kuni 2027

- ▶ kasutusel 10 liikmesriigis:
- ▶ BG, CZ, **EE**, **RO**, SI, LV, AT, DE, **FR**, PL

- ▶ 834 tegevusrühma kasutab multifonde (vähemalt 2 fondi)
- ▶ 621 neist asub kolmes riigis: CZ, PL, RO
- ▶ 333 kasutab EAFRD + ERDF + ESF+
- ▶ 6 tegevusrühma kasutab EAFRD + EMFAF (LV)
